Release Notes 2008-03 V1.4

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Purpose

This document defines the release of build **2008-03** of Grants.gov. It includes the scope, estimated schedule, identifies risks or impacts, functional release notes, as well as recommendations for mitigation and management. In addition, this document provides Acceptance Testing release notes, operational release notes, and Functional Test Cases that satisfy requirements associated with Deliverables 4.5.1 and 4.5.2.

Background

Software changes are collected from various sources as System Change Requests (SCRs) in the PVCS Tracker System. SCRs are categorized and go through a review process established by the Internal Control Board (ICB) of Grants.gov. SCRs gain approval through this process for inclusion in a Build.

Scope

The details of each SCR are listed in Appendix A, Operations Release Notes listed in Appendix B, and the test cases for each SCR are listed in Appendix C. Below is the list of SCR's approved by the ICB to be included in release 2008-03:
